

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 71

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 71 will hold a special meeting on **Monday, August 29, 2016, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 71 Administration Building, Board Meeting Room, 21437 Clay Road, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Security report, and if necessary, convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.076, Texas Government Code, to deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices.
2. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices.
3. Approve Minutes.
4. Report from Acclaim Energy Advisors on demand response program.
5. Report on park, landscape and lake maintenance and repair, including mowing, storm water permitting and fountains, including:
 - (a) Administration Building, including options for kitchen repairs;
 - (b) Bundy Lake Park, including options for repair of bulkhead and programs for monument lighting;
 - (c) Directors Park, including splash pad water usage and options for reuse;
 - (d) other parks and lakes; and
 - (e) review of fountain inventory.
6. Development of District lakes, parks, and recreational facilities, including approve design, authorize advertisement to bid, approve proposals and review bids and award contracts for:
 - (a) additional improvements to Lone Star Lake;
 - (b) improvements to Mirror Lake;
 - (c) additional improvements at Bundy Lake Park and Plaza;
 - (d) additional improvements at Directors Park; and
 - (e) other planned capital improvements.
7. Operation of District facilities, including repair and maintenance, report on investigation of customer appeals and customer correspondence, and replacement of fence behind Coldwater Canyon.
8. Update regarding Water Wise sponsorship, including confirmation of curriculum implementation.
9. Engineering matters, including:
 - (a) potential purchase of 6-acre tract at Crestbrook Cove and Mason Road;
 - (b) review bids and award contract for Bridgewater Meadows, Section 4; and
 - (c) authorize re-advertisement for bids for Lakes of Mason Park, Section 5 and Lakes of Mason Park, Section 6.
